Martial Arts and Crafts

Our Martial Arts and Crafts Summer Camp will run from June 13-17 and 20-24 from 9 am. – 4 p.m. Cost varies based on the amount of time you want to attend.

For our current intermediate students, three hours a day will be credited to your martial arts hours. For new students and our

beginner students, if you attend for both weeks, you will test for rank at the end of the two weeks!

We have a lot of exciting crafts planned this year including many of the favorites from last year like finger painting and paper mache dino eggs and masks.

Coding Camp



will run July 18-22, from 1 -4 p.m.

The cost is \$75 (\$65 for ETTSD members and active military.)

It is BYOL (Bring your own laptop.)

Instead of just playing video games, kids can learn to create their own 3-D games using Kodu Game Designer. Kodu uses a drag and drop environment with a combination of pictures and words. Using it is so intuitive that even a first grader could create a playable game.

Creating Kodu games also helps children use their creativity to develop storytelling skills and learn to solve problems. Every game a child creates will be as unique as a piece of child's artwork. They have fun, build games and play them, all the while learning the fundamentals of programming.
